A. DEFERRED AGENDA

1.E-Mail from Angela LoRusso concerned about Stewart Avenue Intersection.

Attached please find e-mail from Angela LoRusso regarding the traffic danger at the corner of New Hyde Park Road and Stewart Avenue.

DECISION: Defer to Western Property Owners' Association with recommendation of No Right Turn on Red East/West on Stewart. Letter to Nassau County to check the timing of light.

DECISION: The Traffic Commission at its April 21, 2016 meeting voted to defer this item until word from Nassau County Department of Public Works is received that the timing has been adjusted.

DECISION: The Traffic Commission deferred this item at the April 21, 2016 meeting

Additional Information

Nassau County Traffic Signal Division did go out and check the intersection of New Hyde Park Road and Stewart Avenue. They did make minor changes to the signal timing to help reduce the speeding problem. We had also sent them traffic accident history from Commissioner Jackson's office and they have forwarded that data to their Traffic Engineering Division for review.

The WPOA also sent in a letter of support for corrections to this intersection.

Decision: The Traffic Commission at the June 16, 2016 meeting voted to approve a no right turn on red (east and west) turning north and south and request that Nassau County install the no turn on red sign.

3. **Letter from Tricia Schettino of 62 Whitehall Blvd.**

Ms. Schettino requests a four way stop sign on Whitehall Blvd. at the intersection of Salisbury Avenue. She submitted a computer petition with the e-mail.

DECISION: The Traffic Commission deferred this item at the April 21, 2016 meeting

Additional Information

Estates POA voted in favor of a 4-way stop sign at Salisbury and Whitehall Blvd. and have placed this on the June 16, 2016 Agenda.

Decision: The Traffic Commission at the June 16, 2016 meeting voted in favor of the two (2) additional stop signs making the intersection a four-way stop sign intersection. The Traffic Commission voted to adopt the MUTCD standard for stop signs a Village Guide.

B. **NEW BUSINESS.**

1. **Letter of March 30, 2016 – 52 Poplar Street**

Ms. Mimnaugh requests that the No-Parking restriction (2 hours, 8-6 except Sat, Sun. & holidays) be extended past the driveway of her house. EPOA has approved this request to be placed on the June 16, 2016 Agenda.

Decision: The Traffic Commission at the June 16, 2016 meeting voted to approve the extension of the 2-hour 8-6 parking restriction just past #52 Poplar Street.

2. **Letter of March 20, 2016 – Residents of Lindbergh Street**

Residents of Lindbergh Street are requesting a three-way stop sign at the intersection of Meadow Street and Lindbergh Street.

The EPOA did not endorse the addition of the stop signs.

Decision: The Traffic Commission at the June 16, 2016 meeting voted to defer this request and the Police will survey Lindbergh Street in September when school is in session.

3. **Letter of April 1, 2016 – East of Kensington on Merillon**

Mr. Rothendiller requests 2-hour parking signs on both sides of the street east of Kensington and Merillon to Whitehall and Merillon.

Estates POA approved this request to be placed on the June 16, 2016 Agenda.

Additional Information

Letter of May 31, 2016 – 194 Whitehall Blvd

Mr. & Mrs. Mitchell request extending the 2-hour parking restriction on the north side of Merillon Avenue from Kensington Road to Brompton Road and on the south side from Kensington Road to Whitehall Blvd. Whitehall Blvd. to Brompton Road already has 2-hour parking.

The Estates POA also approved this request in conjunction with the Rohendiller request.

Decision: The Traffic Commission at the June 16, 2016 meeting voted to approve the Mitchell request which extends the 2-hour parking restriction to Brompton Road on both sides of Merillon Avenue.

4. **E-Mail from Mr. Bellmer**

Attached please find e-mails concerning the proposal of the installation of tell-tales for the Cherry Valley Avenue railroad bridge.

Decision: The Traffic Commission at the June 16, 2016 meeting voted against this request.




