A. NEW BUSINESS

1. Parking on Meadow Street and Meadow Place.

Commissioner Kenneth Jackson reviewed the area with Chris Markin, Craig Bandini and other Police Personnel. It is their recommendation to allow parking on the west side of Meadow Place from the driveway to Main Street. This will add several spaces. There is parking available on the east side of the road with the exception of the front of 2 houses where there is No Parking 8am-6pm. The majority of the available spacing on the east side of Main Street falls under the jurisdiction on the Village of Hempstead. They spoke with the Hempstead Police Department Traffic Lieutenant who states that their No Parking signs were erected recently due to the heavy commercial traffic in the area as well as the new apartment house. It is his opinion that these signs will remain, however, if we wish consideration to allow parking, the Garden City Traffic Commission may address a letter stating same to him and he will present it to the Hempstead Traffic Commission.
