The following items were considered for action.

1. **Approval of Minutes**
 The minutes of September 16, 2015 meeting were approved.

2. **Committee Reports**

Water

Trustee Trouve discussed the EPA's decision concerning Wells 13 & 14. In addition, an inquiry was made regarding the DEP's proposal to use wells while repairing reservoirs. Leo Stimmler expressed concern regarding the need to budget for items such as the water tower and nitrate removal.

Generators

Discussion ensued concerning proposed regulations for Power Generators. Issues concerning noise and location were discussed. It was suggested that as a minimum, permits require licensed plumbers and electricians. Trustee Trouve advised members that she would like to discuss the matter with the new Building Superintendent, Mr. Ausberto Huertas.

High School Report

Trustee Trouve discussed the plan to install medallions on Village storm drains. Mr. McKernan was advised that Robert Mangan has the required medallions. Mr. McKernan indicated they are trying to increase HOPE membership. Trustee Trouve suggested that the EAB offer Community Service opportunities for HOPE members.

Land Use

Trustee Trouve reminded members that the EAB is responsible for keeping the B.O.T. appraised of land inventory and discussed different land, property and park classifications.

The meeting adjourned at 7:40 P.M.
