

Significant adverse impacts on public health and safety will be avoided by implementation of the requirements set forth in the Hazardous Materials and Construction chapters (Chapters 8 and 9, respectively). These requirements include: (i) compliance with applicable laws relating to asbestos containing material, lead-based paint, and petroleum storage facilities; (ii) air monitoring and dust control measures; and (iii) equipment cleaning procedures.

These and other requirements are specified in greater detail in Chapters 8 and 9.
