JUNIOR ALVARADO

We had the pleasure of presenting famed jockey Junior Alvarado with a Village citation at the June 26, 2025 Board meeting. Fresh off his 2025 Kentucky Derby and Belmont Stakes wins, riding three-year-old horse Sovereignty, Junior, a Garden City resident, had an extraordinary spring. We recognized his ability, passion and dedication to making a profound and lasting impact on the American thoroughbred racing profession. In part, the citation reads: "The Village of Garden City is honored to recognize and celebrate Junior Alvarado as a champion jockey and trailblazer who brings tremendous pride to the Garden City community." Junior is originally from Venezuela where his father was also a jockey. He has had an extraordinary career with over 2,000 wins, including earning a Triple Crown win in the 2021 Preakness on Rombauer, Breeders' Cup championships and the 2023 Pegasus World Cup Invitational.

TREE LIMB TRIMMING

Recreation and Parks crews are busy with resident and Police Department requests for trimming and pruning, and removing damaged and leaning trees around the Village. Annually, Garden City Police perform Village-wide checks and create a list of locations where trimming or removal of tree branches could extend the visibility of traffic lights for approaching traffic. Officers also report locations when observed on daily patrols. This is another example of various Village Departments working together to improve the overall safety of residents and visitors alike. Residents may report tree trimming needs directly to the Village.
