VILLAGE OF GARDEN CITY WATER DEPARTMENT PUBLIC NOTICE

The Incorporated Village of Garden City found elevated levels of lead in the drinking water in some homes/buildings and has exceeded the action level for lead. Specifically, *this action level was exceeded in 14 of 65 homes tested* in required compliance samples in the six-month monitoring ending on June 30, 2022. Under the Authority of the Safe Drinking Water Act, EPA set the action level for lead in drinking water at 15 parts per billion. This means public water suppliers must ensure that water from the customer's tap does not exceed this level in at least 90 percent of the homes in required compliance samples (90th percentile value). The action level is *the concentration of a contaminant which, if exceeded, triggers treatment or other requirements which a water system must follow*. If water exceeds this limit, the water supplier must take certain steps to correct the problem.
