

SAMPLE BALLOT

DIRECTIONS FOR VOTING ON THE VOTING MACHINE

How to Close the Curtain

Swing the large red lever from left to right as far as it will go. This closes the curtain and unlocks the machine for voting.

How to Vote for Candidates

Pull down the lever over the name of each candidate for whom you wish to vote. Move lever from this position to this position

AND
LEAVE
IT DOWN!

If you wish to write in a candidate whose name does not appear on the ballot, push up the cover of the slot at the top of the machine ABOVE THE COLUMN FOR THAT OFFICE. Hold the cover up with one hand and write in the candidate's name on the exposed paper, with the other hand. Once the slot has been opened, all levers for candidate on the ballot in that column are locked and cannot be used (except when more than one candidate is to be elected).

How to Vote on Questions

Questions, if any appear, above the candidates' section. Pull down the YES or NO lever above each question, and LEAVE IT DOWN.

How to Open the Machine

Your votes are not actually registered, and therefore can be changed, (except write-ins) until you swing the red lever back from right to left. No one can tell how you voted, because this action returns all levers to the up position as it opens the curtain.

REMINDERS

BE SURE TO LEAVE LEVERS DOWN over your choices. If you push them up again your votes will not register.
