Dear Resident:

Recent amendments to the NYS Public Service Law §32 direct that, although you would continue to owe the money, your water service cannot be terminated for non-payment of an overdue charge during the COVID-19 State of Emergency. If your service has been terminated for non-payment during the COVID-19 state of emergency, it must be restored.

If non-payment was the result of a change in your financial circumstances due to the COVID-19 state of emergency, your water service cannot be terminated for non-payment of an overdue charge for 180 days after the emergency is lifted or expires.

Please contact the Village of Garden City Water Department at [waterbilling@gardencityny.net](mailto:waterbilling@gardencityny.net), if non-payment was the result of a change in your financial circumstances from the COVID-19 state of emergency, as you may be entitled to enter into a deferred payment agreement (without down payment, late fees or penalties) for your water service.
