RECYCLING Collection Guidelines



COLLECTION DAY:

Collections are from curbside on your assigned pick-up day except as noted on the holiday schedule. The recycling bucket should be used for commingled recyclables only and placed on the curb the night prior to scheduled collection, but not before 7:00 p.m.

COMMINGLED RECYCLABLES:

- These items should be cleaned and placed in the bucket, not mixed with other items such as paper or unacceptable items. Plastic bagged recyclables will not be accepted.
- Commingled recycling consists of plastics (1 and 2 in the triangle on the bottom of the containers only), glass bottles and cans only.

Examples of acceptable items - soda and water bottles, salad dressing bottles, milk jugs, shampoo and conditioner bottles, wine bottles and aluminum cans.

Not acceptable items - plastic bags, buckets, soap dispenser bottles, wax paper containers, Chinese food containers, toys, flower pots, light bulbs, window glass, mirrors, ceramic dishes and mugs, paint cans, aerosol cans, books and wire hangers.

PAPER (NEWSPAPER, MAGAZINES, PHONE BOOKS):

- Paper must be tied securely and placed on or next to the recycling container.
- **DO NOT** use plastic bags to hold paper items.
- Brown paper bags and junk mail can be included with the newspapers.

METALS:

- All metal items should be placed at the curb on your assigned recycling day.
- Metal items include bicycles, bed frames, car parts, cabinets, refrigerators, microwaves, stoves and other appliances.
- **Law requires that the doors from refrigerators and freezers must be removed when placed to the curb.**
- **Metal items will be picked-up when your Green Bucket is collected or in the afternoon with a special collection truck.**

E-WASTE:

- Please call the Village Yard directly to schedule all e-waste items for pickup. This includes computers, televisions, DVD players and VCRs.
- **Not acceptable** - microwaves, stereos and telephones.
- All E-Waste items may also be brought to the Village Yard Dump during normal operating hours.

ADDITIONAL RECYCLING REMINDERS AND NOTICES

Green Recycling Buckets are given to the homeowners for commingled recycling only and remain the property of the Village of Garden City. Paper should not be placed in the recycling bucket.

SANITATION Collection Guidelines



GARBAGE: All kitchen waste will be collected at the rear or along the side of the home, screened from street view in plastic bags tied securely or in watertight covered containers not to exceed 32 gallons and/or 40 pounds per container. Small boxes such as, but not limited to, cereal, pizza, shirt and shoe boxes are considered kitchen waste. **Never place broken glass in with the garbage.**

GRASS CLIPPINGS: Grass clippings are collected at the curb in plastic bags, bushel baskets or garbage cans not exceeding 32 gallons and/or 40 pounds per container. Grass clippings are collected on the same days as garbage: May 1 through October 1. **LANDSCAPERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE REMOVAL AND DISPOSAL OF THEIR MATERIAL.**

RUBBISH: All rubbish is collected at the curb each Wednesday (except as noted on the Holiday Schedule). Tree branches must be cut and tied in bundles not more than 4 feet in length and 18 inches in diameter. Large cartons should be reduced in size and tied in bundles not larger than 2 feet by 2 feet by 2 feet. Bushel baskets or containers not larger than 32 gallons and/or 40 pounds per container may also be used. Cat litter, dog waste and other animal feces are included in this category and **MUST** be placed in plastic bags tied securely for health reasons. Cardboard, rags and books are also considered rubbish. Rubbish must be stored in an area screened from street view prior to it being placed at the curb for collection. **Broken glass should be boxed and marked and placed in rubbish container.**

BULKY ITEMS: Furniture, wood, stumps or any large amount of material. Please call for a special pickup **BEFORE** placing material at the curb. Hours to call for a special pickup are between 7:00 a.m. and 3:30 p.m., Monday-Friday, (516) 465-4031. Please be aware that there will be no special pickups on the day that Village-wide rubbish collection is scheduled. **CONTRACTORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE REMOVAL AND DISPOSAL OF THEIR MATERIAL.**

HAZARDOUS MATERIALS: The Village does **NOT** collect oil or chemical drums, cartridges or explosives, chemicals, paints, gasoline or any other flammable, volatile or combustible liquids. For information on the disposal of these items, call the Town of Hempstead S.T.O.P. Program at (516) 378-4210.

TIRES: The Village **DOES NOT** collect tires.

BUILDING CONSTRUCTION: The Village does not collect rubbish from building construction, alterations or repairs if the work was done by a contractor. **CONTRACTORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE REMOVAL AND DISPOSAL OF THEIR MATERIAL.**

TIME OF COLLECTION:

Refuse should be placed at the curb or made available by 6:00 a.m. on the day of collection, but not prior to 7:00 p.m. the evening before.

ADDITIONAL SANITATION REMINDERS:

Please keep the path to your garbage cans clear. Please remove items such as snow/ice, cars, sprinklers, bushes and dogs.



Important SANITATION & RECYCLING Information

MUNICIPAL SERVICE YARD

The Village Transfer Station was established for the convenience of Village residents. It is located just south of the entrance to the Community Park Complex on Cherry Valley Avenue. Its use is limited to passenger cars, station wagons and suburban type vehicles including small vans with full windows all around. All trucks, vans and commercial vehicles are prohibited.

HOURS

Weekdays: 9:00 a.m. to 11:45 a.m. and 12:30 p.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Saturdays: 8:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Sunday: CLOSED

Hazardous materials including oil, gasoline, chemicals, paints and any other highly flammable or volatile liquids will not be accepted at the Transfer Station. For information on the disposal of these items, call the Town of Hempstead S.T.O.P. Program at (516) 378-4210.

Items accepted at the Village Yard include rubbish, yard waste, as well as bulky items. No household garbage will be accepted. No building construction materials for work done by a contractor will be accepted. **CONTRACTORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE REMOVAL AND DISPOSAL OF THEIR MATERIAL.**

Residents who wish to use the Transfer Station must obtain a permit. Permits can be obtained in person at the Business Office/Clerk's Office on the first floor of Village Hall. You must present a valid registration for your vehicle along with the required fee.



REQUIREMENTS FOR USING THE VILLAGE TRANSFER STATION:

1. All vehicles must be registered to a Garden City address.
2. All vehicles must have a permit.
3. All permits must be on front left bumper.
4. No commercial use.
5. No household garbage will be accepted.
