

Chapter 18: Short- and Long-Term, Cumulative, and Other Impacts

The chapters above discuss in detail the impacts that would be expected with the Proposed Action. The Proposed Action would be completed in approximately one year. Impacts that would occur in the short-term are generally the construction impacts, which would be temporary and not significant. Long-term impacts include changes in land use and open space and historic and visual impacts. Mitigation measures are proposed for potential significant adverse impacts. In addition, the Proposed Action would result in a positive long-term open space benefit.
